

## Immunization Requirements All Kindergarten Entrants and Entrants New to the School District in Grades 1-12

To Enter School: State law (Part 92, Act 368 of the Public Acts of 1978, as amended) prohibits a principal or teacher from admitting new entrants to school without a record of having received at least one dose of each: Measles, mumps, rubella, polio, diphtheria, tetanus, pertussis, hepatitis B, and varicella.

To Stay in School: You must provide the school with a record showing that your child has received all of the following immunizations:

**CHILDREN WHO HAVE NOT RECEIVED THE REQUIRED IMMUNIZATIONS WILL BE EXCLUDED FROM SCHOOL UNTIL PARENTS PROVIDE PROOF THAT ALL REQUIRED IMMUNIZATIONS HAVE BEEN GIVEN, OR HAVE A WAIVER ON FILE.**

<b>Diphtheria, Tetanus &amp; Pertussis*</b>	<p><b>4 doses are required.</b> If a dose was not given on or after the 4<sup>th</sup> birthday, a booster dose of DTP is required.</p>	<p><b>4 doses are required.</b> If a dose was not given in the last 10 years, a booster dose of Td is required.</p>
<b>Polio</b>	<p><b>3 doses are required.</b> If the last dose was not given on or after the 4<sup>th</sup> birthday, a booster dose is required.</p>	<p><b>3 doses are required.</b></p>
<b>Measles, Mumps &amp; Rubella</b>	<p><b>2 doses are required.</b> The 1<sup>st</sup> dose must be given on or after the 1<sup>st</sup> birthday. The 2<sup>nd</sup> dose must be given at least 28 days from the 1<sup>st</sup> dose.</p>	<p><b>2 doses are required.</b> The 1<sup>st</sup> dose must be given on or after the 1<sup>st</sup> birthday. The 2<sup>nd</sup> dose must be given at least 28 days from the 1<sup>st</sup> dose.</p>
<b>Hepatitis B</b>	<p><b>3 doses are required.</b></p>	<p><b>3 doses are required.</b></p>
<b>Varicella (Chickenpox) **</b>	<p><b>1 dose is required.</b> This dose must be administered on or after the 1<sup>st</sup> birthday.</p>	<p><b>1 dose is required</b> if received on or after the 1<sup>st</sup> birthday and prior to the 13<sup>th</sup> birthday <u>OR</u> <b>2 doses are required</b>, administered at least 28 days apart, if the child received the 1<sup>st</sup> dose on or after the 13<sup>th</sup> birthday.</p>

\* Children ages 4-6 must have received 4 doses of pertussis. DT is only accepted if a signed waiver is on file for that particular dose of pertussis vaccine.

\*\* Reliable history of chickenpox disease or proof of current lab immunity are both acceptable in lieu of the vaccine.
