

HIGH SCHOOL COMPLETION / GED

Testing starts at 5:00 pm each day and the testing session can last until 10:00 pm.

Cost: \$160 for the entire test battery; \$32 per test or retest.

Accommodations are available for people with special needs.

Requirements for taking the GED: Pictured identification is required for each examinee. Each examinee needs to know their Social Security number.

Minimum Age: is 18 years, unless one of the following conditions is met:

- The person has been out of school for one year
- The examination is court ordered
- The person is entering military service

Testing under special conditions requires a letter of verification substantiating the information. The examinee's high school class must have graduated before any certificate will be issued, no matter what the individual's age.
