

Student Evaluation Rubric

The following rubric is used to evaluate student accomplishment in choir. These scales will be based on age appropriate learning and progress.

Score	Students will sing correct pitches.
4.0 Advanced	Student sings correct pitches with no error and demonstrates fluent music reading skills.
3.0 Proficient	Student sings correct pitches with little error and demonstrates good music reading skills.
2.0 Developing	Student often sings correct pitches and makes an effort to demonstrate music reading skills.
1.0 Remedial	Student makes an effort to sing some correct pitches and to demonstrate music reading skills.
0.0 No Effort	Student makes no effort to sing correct pitches. Student makes no effort to demonstrate music reading skills.

Score	Students will sing correct rhythms.
4.0 Advanced	Student sings correct rhythms with no error and demonstrates fluent music reading skills.
3.0 Proficient	Student sings correct rhythms with little error and demonstrates good music reading skills.
2.0 Developing	Student often sings correct rhythms and makes an effort to demonstrate music reading skills.
1.0 Remedial	Student makes an effort to sing some correct rhythms and to demonstrate music reading skills.
0.0 No Effort	Student makes no effort to sing correct rhythms. Student makes no effort to demonstrate music reading skills.

Score	Students will understand and demonstrate good tone.
4.0 Advanced	Student demonstrates excellent and mature vocal production and tone.
3.0 Proficient	Student demonstrates good vocal production and tone.
2.0 Developing	Student demonstrates a developing vocal production and tone.
1.0 Remedial	Student demonstrates an effort to produce proper vocal tone.
0.0 No Effort	Student makes no effort to demonstrate vocal tone.

Score	Students will demonstrate and describe proper singing technique.
4.0 Advanced	Student consistently demonstrates and can describe proper singing technique.
3.0 Proficient	Student often demonstrates and can describe proper singing technique.
2.0 Developing	Student sometimes demonstrates proper singing technique. Student can describe some elements of proper singing technique.
1.0 Remedial	Student does not yet understand or demonstrate proper singing technique.
0.0 No Effort	Student makes no effort to demonstrate or describe proper singing technique.

Score	Students will be a contributing member of the choir, showing their best effort and a positive attitude.
4.0 Advanced	Student is consistently prepared and participating. Student demonstrates excellent effort and attitude.
3.0 Proficient	Student is prepared and participating. Student demonstrates good effort and attitude.
2.0 Developing	Student is sometimes prepared and participating. Student demonstrates some effort.
1.0 Remedial	Student is rarely prepared or participating. Student demonstrates little effort.
0.0 No Effort	Student is not prepared or participating. Student makes no effort and displays poor attitude.

Learning will be assessed by daily participation, performances and tests (written or oral).

Choir is an elective class. You are here because you like to sing and perform. As a member of the choir it is very important to remember that what you do directly impacts all members of the group. Remember: What you gain from a class is largely dependent on what you contribute. Effort and attitude are very important!
