-  **Charlotte Public Schools provide a wide variety of nutritious food to our students daily to promote good health and education.**
-  **We offer breakfast and lunch at our high school, middle school and elementary schools. The United States Department of Agriculture (USDA) regulates the National School Breakfast and Lunch Programs. Schools, like ours, must follow the meal patterns and portion sizes developed by the USDA.**
-  **A school lunch consists of a choice of a main dish, a choice of two fruits and vegetables, a bread item, and milk. A school breakfast consists of two choices of grain, bread, yogurt, or protein items, juice or fruit, and milk.**
-  **Your children may qualify for free or reduced price meals if you receive food stamps or your household income is within the limits on the Federal Income Guidelines. Information and applications are mailed mid-August to each household in the Charlotte school district. Applications are also available at each school office and may be completed anytime during the school year or if your family income changes.**
-  **Our food service debit system combines all siblings to one family account. Payments can be mailed to our office, sent to school with your child or an electronic fund deposit at our CPS web page.**
-  **For Internet access to view your student's food service account contact our Technology Department at 541-5750.**
-  **Menus are distributed to the buildings on a monthly basis and are posted on the CPS web page.**
