



## **Charlotte Education Foundation Classroom Grants**

**2011-2012**

The Charlotte Public Schools Education Foundation (CPSEF) is pleased to announce that Charlotte Public School teachers may once again apply for “*Classroom Mini-Grants*” for the 2011-2012 school year. This is the third year that up to \$200 per request will be awarded to fund projects that impact student achievement and support state mandated curriculum standards.

Grant applications are currently available on the school district web site and are included with this e-mail to all CPS teachers. Grant requests are read by CPSEF board members who evaluate the proposal’s details and completeness, impact on student achievement, student benefit, timeline, budget, coordination with state mandated curriculum and strength of the project evaluation plan. **Applications are due to Sheryl Baker at CPS Central Office no later than August 26, 2011. Mini-grants will be awarded by the CPSEF board on September 9, 2011.**

During the two previous school years, six mini-grants were awarded. The CPSEF Board hopes that interest will increase by providing this grant information so teachers can work on the application during the summer. We look forward to supporting valuable projects that provide great learning experiences for students.
