



Athletic Hall of Fame
Established 2017

In 2018, the Charlotte Athletic Department will be inducting their first class of alumni into the Charlotte Athletic Department Hall of Fame. The athletes, teams, coaches or community members that will be inducted will have the highest level of accomplishments or service to our community and athletic program. This will be done by a 5 person panel that has been formed after the approval is given by the Board of Education. The panel will deliberate and vote on candidates that are brought forward. A super majority vote will put someone, or a team into the class for induction.

There will be four possible categories of inductees for the Athletic Hall of Fame.

Student Athletes Any athlete who has distinguished their athletic career while at CHS by meeting the following criteria.

- Earned at least one varsity letter at CHS and graduated from CHS.
- A student-athlete who made a significant impact on CHS athletics, had an outstanding career, demonstrated good character, and achieved acceptable academic standards.
- A student-athlete can be nominated 5 years after their graduating class has graduated from CHS.
- Other criteria to consider: school records held, all-state honors, college accomplishments, and professional accomplishments.

Teams Any team for a sport that has set themselves apart from other teams for Charlotte by meeting some of the following criteria.

- Undefeated seasons, championships, or MHSAA tournament success.
- Rare accomplishments by a team or first time accomplishments by a team.
- The team must be 5 years away from their successful season.

Coaches Any coach for Charlotte Public Schools with exceptional character or accomplishments and has set themselves apart from the other coaches at Charlotte.

- Coaches who have won championships, or made it to a certain level in the MHSAA tournament.
- Coaches who have had an extended career with documented success.
- A coach will be eligible after 3 years of retiring from coaching that sport.

Community Member Any administrator, community member, volunteer coach or exceptional athletic supporter from the community who meets some of the criteria below.

- Someone who has volunteered an excessive amount of time, money, or resources to the student athletes of Charlotte.
- Someone who has been a supporter of the athletic department and has always been in good standing with our coaches, players and administrators.
- Someone who has always thought about what is best for our kids and strived to make our facilities, programs, or community better.

- ◆ *All candidates must be in good standing with the district and be a positive representation of the best Charlotte Athletics has to offer.*
- ◆ *All nominations are turned in to the athletic office by March 15th of the current year.*
- ◆ *The committee will follow up with questions to the person nominating the candidate. After all information is gathered the committee will vote to determine who will be in the induction class for the following year.*
- ◆ *Each year that we have candidates that are voted in we will hold one or more ceremonies to induct the hall of fame class.*
- ◆ *All candidates must receive a super majority of 4 out of 5 votes from the hall of fame committee to receive induction into the Charlotte Athletic Hall of Fame.*
- ◆ *Under certain circumstances there may be only 4 voting members which would then mean the candidate would need a 3 out of 4 vote to be inducted.*
