On September 30, 2014, Charlotte Public Schools was one of only five schools in Michigan to receive the Safety is No Accident award from SET SEG. Each year, SET SEG recognizes five members for outstanding efforts in reducing claims and supporting and promoting exemplary safety measures among employees. Charlotte Public Schools was recognized for their diligent efforts at safety, reducing workers' compensation claims, and

implementing proper best practices. Some specific improvements have come with proper and timely accident investigation and reporting, use of transitional duties, utilization of *Safe Schools* online training sessions, and by properly maintaining District facilities and grounds.
