Come “Bash the Trash” with us at CPAC on November 11



The Charlotte Performing Arts Center is excited to present the *Bash the Trash: Recycling Remix* on Sunday, November 11 at 2:00 PM.

Bash the Trash builds, performs and educates with musical instruments made from reused and repurposed materials. They combine science, music and environmental awareness through their performances, programs and social initiatives, always focusing on how art and science work together.

Bash the Trash: Recycling Remix combines a concert, instrument-building workshop, and fun parade of instruments all in one fantastic afternoon. During the concert, the musicians will play instruments made from recycled materials. They will share their knowledge with kids in attendance who get an opportunity to make their own recycled material instruments during a special post-show workshop. After the workshop, everyone will parade around CPAC with their recycled instruments, making music together.
