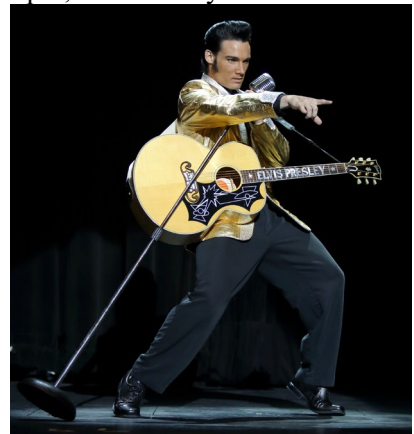
## Tickets on Sale for 2019-20 Charlotte Performing Arts Center events

The Charlotte Performing Arts Center is up and running for another season of must-see events! Tickets are on sale Saturday, September 14 (online) and Monday, September 16 (phone and walk-in) for several upcoming performances you won't want to miss! This season brings many new and exciting things, as well as some past favorites, to the CPAC stage.

The **CHARLOTTE COMMUNITY BAND** takes the stage for two concerts this season, Thursday, October 3, 2019 at 7:00 PM and Saturday, December 14, 2019 at 7:00 PM. Advance tickets are \$8 for adults, \$5 for students and seniors (62+). All tickets are \$10 at the door. Seating is general admission.

The Charlotte High School Drama Department will perform **Seussical The Musical** in November. "Oh, the things you can think" when Dr. Seuss' best-loved characters collide and cavort in an unforgettable musical caper. Performances are November 1 – 3, 2019. Friday & Saturday at 7:00 pm, and Sunday afternoon at 3:00 pm. Advance tickets are \$12 for adults, \$10 for seniors, and \$6 for children/students. All tickets are \$15 at the door on the day of the performance. Seating is reserved.

**Leo Days as Elvis** comes to the performing arts center on Saturday, November 16, 2019 at 7:00 pm. Whether it is the raw Elvis of the 50s, the sexy 60s leather Elvis, or polished Vegas Elvis, Leo Days has every move, mannerism, and the voice of the King. In late January & early February, the Arts for Youth Onstage Experience presents **DISNEY'S FROZEN JR.** A story of true love and acceptance between sisters, Frozen JR. expands upon the emotional relationship and journey between Princesses Anna and Elsa. When faced with danger, the two discover their hidden potential and the powerful bond of sisterhood. With a cast of beloved characters and loaded with magic, adventure, and plenty of humor, Frozen JR. is sure to thaw even the coldest heart! Performances are January 31, 2020 & February 1, 2020 at 7:00 PM, and February 1 & 2, 2020 at 3:00 PM. Advance tickets are \$10.00 for adults, \$8.00 for seniors, and \$8.00 for students. All tickets are \$12.00 at the door on the day of the performance. Seating is reserved.

The CHS Drama department takes the stage again on March 13 – 15, 2020 with its Spring Musical, **Little Shop of Horrors**. The meek floral assistant Seymour Krelborn stumbles across a new breed of plant he names "Audrey II" - after his coworker crush. This foul-mouthed, R&B-singing carnivore promises unending fame and fortune to the down and out Krelborn as long as he keeps feeding it, BLOOD. Over time, though, Seymour discovers Audrey II's out of this world origins and intent towards global domination! Advance tickets are \$12 for Adults, \$10 for Seniors (62+), and \$6 for Students. This year CPAC has introduced a new limited seating series called the **"Brunch &" Series**. They have selected 3 artists to headline the series that all have local ties to Charlotte. On Sunday, October 13, 2019, **Brunch & Classics** will featuring Charlotte alum Josh Holliday. An afternoon of entertainment featuring a variety of show tunes and classics, Josh is a natural entertainer who is sure to delight the crowds with his charisma and musicality.

Continuing the series, on Sunday, February 9, 2020, Frenz will appear for an afternoon of **Brunch & Jazz**. Featuring Don Sare, Jeff English, Jeff Soup, and CPS faculty Kathleen Warriner, Frenz brings a jazz twist to many of your favorite songs.

Finally, **Brunch & Rock** rounds out the series on Sunday, May 3, 2020. A concert featuring lyrically focused acoustic blending of Americana and riff driven blues and rock, don't miss CHS alum Adam Droscha on the CPAC stage!

All **"Brunch &" Series** events begin at 2:00 PM with light brunch served. The concert takes place during brunch in an intimate setting right on the CPAC stage. Tickets to each are \$15.00 Adults, \$12.00 Students/Seniors (62+). Brunch is provided by the Eaton Area Senior Center. A discount is available for those purchasing all three "Brunch &" Series events as a package.

Our final special event is the popular **Charlotte Idol** competition, which this year includes a **Charlotte Idol Jr** competition as well. The finals will take place on Saturday, July 18, 2020 at 7:00 PM. Tickets are \$10.00 all seats. Seating is general admission. More information will be available in January for those interested in entering the competition.
