Hello, All,

As always, we are continuously working to perfect our dismissal and pick up procedures that provide the upmost safety for all students. One of the issues we continue to have are parents/pick up family members who park at the curb and leave their cars and wait for their students to exit the building. This slows our pick up line down and prompts cars waiting to drive around the parked cars.



Starting tonight, we are asking all pick up car students to go to the flag pole. Students will not be dismissed from their classroom line to enter cars as they walk down the sidewalk to the buses. Please stay in your cars and slowly drive to the flag pole. There, the first cars will have students released to them, they move, then the first 3 cars move forward.

Also, tonight I will be in the pick up lane with a "Parkview Pick Up Parent" sign for you to display on your dashboard on the passenger side. There will be a line for you to write your child's(ren) name. This will identify you as a parent that has a child in the pick up line. If the sign is not displayed, our paraprofessional/or other staff member may ask you for identification of who your are picking up.

Please do not pass cars in the single line pick up line or drive over the cones to pass others. We realize this is a slow process, but patience is the key to safety. Please be reminded that our staff is on duty until 4:05. If you are not here, your child will be safely inside the office.

Thank you to our parents who park in the provided parking spaces and walk to the school to pick up their children. Please escort your child back across the pick up lane at the beginning of the pick up line, holding their hand if necessary. Walking in between cars is dangerous, as well as, motioning the students across to you.

I appreciate you working with us to continue to get our students to and from school safely. I know none of you would ever want one our families and/or students hurt when patience, going slowly, and being tolerant is the solution. Thank you for your support. KIM
